

Announcement for 2012 NWS Taunton Summer Student Interns

The National Weather Service (NWS) in Taunton, MA is accepting applications for our Summer Student Intern Program through March 1, 2012.

This program is open to undergraduate students majoring in meteorology (or any of the physical sciences) or to graduate students with a background in meteorology. The purpose of the program is to give students the opportunity to learn more about careers in the NWS by gaining on-the-job experience. Several of our former Summer Student Interns have been hired by the NWS as Meteorologist Interns after graduation.

Summer Student Interns will work on a research project and spend time shadowing operational forecasters. Job shadows are also arranged with the Northeast River Forecast Center (which is located in our facility) as well as the NWS Center Weather Service Unit (CWSU), which is located at the Boston Air Route Traffic Control Center in Nashua, NH and provides weather support to the FAA.

This year, we have two positions available. Experience with computers is preferred, but not required. Applications should consist of a letter of interest and resume, which highlights your skills and interests in meteorology. There are two ways to apply:
