| September 18, 2004 | 28.13      | 111,000          | Remnants of Hurricane Ivan.   |
| November 26, 1950  | 27.61      | missing          | Record breaking cold air spawned a coastal "bomb" that retrograded back to the lower Great Lakes underneath a deep closed vortex. |
